Women at the Well Dialogues

CCA's on-going formation program: *Women at the Well Dialogues* will host an Advent prayer service entitled *God Draws Near: Watching in Silence and Hope* on November 30th. Sr. Liz Sweeney, SSJ will lead the sisters in prayer as we gather to share the in-breaking of God in our lives through the lens of the Advent Scriptures. Sr. Liz will join us again in January to explore the unitive possibilities that emerge between us when we allow Christ, 'our luminous center', to move us toward a new vision for our lives.

Shared Services Collaborative

The Shared Services Collaborative is the bridge between the generations and spans them all. It provides the administrative support that empowers the younger leaders to focus more attentively on the

ministry of prayer, provides the assurance of logistical continuity of care for our older members, and enables them to live their contemplative life more fully. This program will provide a broad range of services and will address financial, purchasing, and insurance needs. We are still actively seeking funding to carry out the implementation of the project.
